#### What We've Been Up To!

\*May 29-30 - EOG testing

Reading: We have been working hard in reading by talking about and reading nonfiction. We are continuing to listen to our "inner conversation" and writing down our thoughts. We are practicing our inferencing skills. Ask your child how they can merge their background knowledge and the clues that the author gives to make their inferences. We are also working hard on finding the topic or main idea of the passage or section in our nonfiction; then we look to find the supporting details for that topic. They are great detectives with this! We continue to look for interesting facts. questions, and responses in our inner conversation as well. Don't forget about tracks!! Another neat thing your third grader is finding as a detective, are the meanings of words. Be sure to look at the back of your child's reading log this month. They need to find five words that they are not sure of and use all the words around that word to find the meaning.

Math: We are wrapping up 2D shapes! We learned all about our *polygons* as well as all the vocabulary. Ask your child what attributes a quadrilateral has to have or how many sides a hexagon is! We will start April off with learning and reviewing our graphs. We will be talking about why we use graphs and how they help us organize all of our data that we find. Then we will be exploring higher numbers with our number sense and reviewing our strategies that we might have gotten rusty on since the beginning of the year.

Science Fun: We will begin our science soil and plant unit this month as well. We will be talking about all the different kinds of soil there are and all of their purposes!
