What We've Been Up To!

Reading: The Daily 5 is up and running in full swing! We have discussed things good readers do while they read. Our brains are always busy while we read. Ask your child about their inner conversation while they are reading. We talked about all the different things that can happen to make meaning break down while we read and then we talked about fix up strategies that can help us become a better reader. Ask your child some different fix up strategies to help them understand and monitor what they read. Remember to ask your child open ended questions about what they read every night after their 25 minutes of reading. This will ensure that they are checking for understanding the way good readers do! Math: We have finished studying addition and subtraction word problems with numbers to 1,000. Ask your child to show how the number line can be used for so many different math problems. The students have used it for elapsed time, problem solving, and three digit addition/subtraction problems! They are experts in this strategy! We will now begin multiplication.

*If you havn't already please read the letter that was sent home about our timed addition tests. It is a very important reference for you to have and use. Thank you for your continued support in your childnt' academic success!
