What We've Been Up To!

Reading: We have just started our new study on poetry. We will discuss how poets have different views and tones in their poems. Did you know that poems don't have to rhyme??? Be sure to ask your child about how poems have rhythm as well!! We have started working on the Fab 5! We will be working on "leaving TRACKS" while we read. This means we listen to what we are thinking, and write it down...this may be questions or wonders, reaction/thoughts, or even words we aren't sure of! Be sure to have your child practice while reading each night! We are now up to 30 minutes every night!

Math: We have finished studying measurement with weight and capacity. We have begun multiplication and have finished our multiplication books! We are now going to be looking into arrays and how they can help us with multiplying. We are going to explore how arrays are in our everyday life. Be sure to ask your child where they can find an array and how they help us.

Science: Mrs. Lane has been doing an amazing job in the STEM lab. Ask your child aboutwhat they are learning in space! Ask them about the moon phases.

Social Studies: We are really working hard on our global awareness standard! Please remind your child to bring in an interesting article from another country.
