*May 29&30 - EOG testing **Reading:** We have been working hard in reading on the skills of inferring. We will be digging deeper into our fiction with fables, fairy tales, and even some poems. We are using our fiction text to infer the meaning of words and better understand events of the story. We will be looking at two stories to compare and contrast the differences and similarities about the characters, setting, plot, etc. Have your child explain our reading equation of "BK + TC = I". We will also be practicing for the EOG by reviewing good test taking strategies. Sample passages will be coming home for homework. Students will need to use their FAB 5 strategies to make tracks.

Math: We will be wrapping up our patterns unit. We have been looking at growing patterns and patterns in a multiplication or addition table. Ask your child about the children in planet Rhomar. [©] We will also begin to work on math test taking strategies and review all of the 3rd grade math concepts. Any help or extra practice at home will be beneficial with your child especially on multi step word problems, comparing fractions, area, and perimeter. Sample math EOG questions will be coming home for homework as well.
