What We've Been Up To!

Reading: The Daily 5 is up and running in full swing! We have studied the skills of authors view point, touched on authors' purpose, and authors' mood. We are now wrapping up literary elements, sequencing, and character traits. Ask your child about the authors' study we did! They can tell you all about the author we have been reading about. Some questions to ask your child: What was their favorite book by the author? Why? Name some of the characters. What were some traits of those characters? We have discussed things good readers do while they read. Our reading brains should always be busy monitoring what we are reading. We have discussed why authors write with our Author's P.I.E.E.! Be sure to ask your child about this and discuss author's purpose with every book your child reads at home! We'll begin studying nonfiction and informational texts this month!

Math: We have worked hard on telling time to the minute and elapsed time. For the first few weeks we will be wrapping up measurement with length and perimeter. We will soon begin the rest of our measurement unit. We will explore weight and capacity!

Science: Mrs. Lane has been doing an amazing job in the STEM lab. Ask your child about their matter! Ask them if the item is a solid, liquid, or gas!

Social Studies: We will be wrapping up government and discussing historical events that happened in our community with our nonfiction texts during reading. Your child can bring in an article to share if they find a historical even that happened in our community! We will be integrating this into reading as much as possible.

Writing: We are working hard on our writer's notebook. Ask your child about their heart or their neighborhood map! Soon we will be publishing our stories from our launching unit of Writer's Workshop and having a "Writer's Celebration" to celebrate all we have learned so far in writing!
